From the Principal's Desk

We have an unprecedented number of staffing changes about to take effect in 2022:

Associate Principal, **Allison Rangī**, resigned in November to take up a position with the Ministry of Education. I am pleased to announce that **Helen Kinsey-Wightman** (currently DP at Palmerston North Girls HS) has been appointed as her replacement.

Our head of English, **Helen Tor**, is taking a well-earned retirement. Since joining the school in 2004 she has made a difference in the lives of hundreds of students. Her skill as a teacher, knowledge of her subject and care for her students is legendary. Our new English HOD is **Brenda Rudolph**, a very experienced teacher who has served on the senior management team of Huanui College and as HOD English at Whangaparaoa College.

Sue Howes, head of Social Sciences, is also moving into retirement following 28 years of outstanding service to the school. She has inspired many students with her passionate and skilful teaching both in the classroom and, more recently, with online classes. Sue has taught a wide range of subjects, in addition to her role as deputy principal for many years. Our new head of Social Sciences is **Ian Callachan**, who has previously taken this role at Mahurangi College. He is currently teaching at Rodney College.

We are delighted to welcome **Delilah Edmonds** (Tikipunga High School) onto our teaching team as head of Technology and teacher of Digital Technology. She is replacing Debbie Anderson, who took up a position at Rodney College in late Term 3.

Our Special Needs Coordinator (SENCO) **Clarissa Tana** has made the difficult decision to leave the school to support a family-run business. Clarissa's care for students, leadership of our Learning Support team, unflinching cheerfulness and total efficiency in administration have been deeply appreciated. From the start of 2022, she will be replaced by **Tashina Hingston**, a very experienced SENCO from Auckland.

Maria Quin stepped aside from her classroom teaching in 2019 and has since been our dedicated library manager. After more than 30 years at the school, this 'living legend' is retiring. Maria's versatility in teaching a wide range of subjects, her efficiency, sense of humour and commitment to the school have been highly valued. In her place, we are welcoming **Tessa Edwards** to the school as our new library manager for three days per week. Tessa has a background as a highly regarded primary school teacher and has more recently completed studies in library management. She will be supported in her work (two days a week) by **Delwyn Morris** and newly appointed **Sue Tomich**.

Also leaving our staff at the end of the year are **Klasina Sewell** (Learning Support Coordinator), **Alice Barber** (Office Administrator) and **Karen Willoughby** (Teacher Aide). Each of these staff members have made valued contributions to the school in their respective roles. I wish them all the best for their future endeavours.

Hollie Brotherhood has been appointed to a fixed term position, teaching Year 3, to provide cover for **Min Kim**, who is on parental leave until August.

Our head of Drama, **Tabitha Kaiser**, is taking refreshment leave in 2022 and will be replaced by the experienced **Debi Walters-Brown**.

Naomi Neumann will join the staff for two days per week to teach music and provide cover for teacher release in the intermediate classes.

We congratulate **Debbie Graham** on her appointment to a full-time teaching position at Whangarei Intermediate from the start of 2022. We greatly appreciate the work Debbie has done with our singing students and in providing classroom release for primary classes over the past six years. We welcome **Karla Galley** onto our music staff as she takes over singing tuition in the school.

Julie Chaplin is adding to her current roles as teacher in charge of Careers and Year 13 Dean, with additional responsibilities as leader of our Gateway programme and STAR (Secondary-Tertiary Alignment Resource).

Christine Allan has been appointed as our Year 12 Dean, taking this role over from **Andrea Cameron**, who is moving to head of sport. Andrea will be continuing her important work as an Across School Teacher, serving ten schools in our Kahui Ako (Community of Learning).

We welcome **Beaudene Bucknell** to our staff, as he takes up a role to support our Trades students. Beaudene has previously worked in the school on a contract basis, and we are delighted to secure his services on a more permanent basis.
